Dear Parents,

Great news!

We are now able to confirm our plans for the nursery move- we apologise for not being able to give details any sooner- we have been waiting for approval from Ofsted since the start of November and yesterday they granted this! Our new registration number is EY555413.

As we have to vacate Unit 11 and leave it completely empty on 22nd December, it is sadly not possible to move to the new setting over the Christmas holidays as has been suggested. We will also have a fair bit of equipment & toys to sell off (so if there is anything that you would be interested in- then please let Becky and Rosa know and make us an offer), donate to charity, recycle etc. and we need time to do this and clean the premises during the last week of term.

This coming weekend we, along with some members of staff, will be moving equipment from Unit 11 to the new site- it is our intentions to move most of the larger pieces of furniture and toys so that children can start at the new site during the week commencing 4th December- we understand that working over two sites may cause some parents with siblings issues over drop off and collection so we will try to make this as easy and quick a transition as is possible.

From Tuesday 5th December babies should be dropped off and collected from the new site. Hopefully soon after that, we will be able to inform you when the toddlers and pre-schoolers will join them.



In relation to the premises themselves, we have three interconnecting rooms downstairs each for toddlers and pre-schoolers and these have free-flow access to their individual gardens. The shelters are being moved as we write and the astro turf will be following...

The babies and ASC will be based upstairs along with the staff room and the nursery kitchen. The babies also have their own dedicated garden and of course ASC will be able to utilise the pre-school gardens.

As you look at the nursery from Bristol Road- there are two entrances to the premises- please enter by the left hand drive and exit via the right hand drive- we will be operating a one way system and signs will be erected to indicate this is due course. The driveway in front of the building will be for parent drop off and collections- we have calculated that with careful and considerate parking 10 vehicles can park here at one time. The long driveway to the left of the building does not belong to the nursery- it is the property of Severn Trent and they need 24/7 access so please do not block this driveway!

Babies and toddlers should be dropped off and collected from the main front entrance of the nursery premises and pre-schoolers should be dropped off and collected using the entrance to the left hand side of the building which has direct access to the pre-school rooms.

We very much hope that you are as delighted with our new premises as we are- although they are smaller, we feel they are much more cosy and child centric and best of all, they are ours!
