## Democracy

### Making decisions together-

At BarBar Nursery Ltd our planning and activities are led by the children. They tell us or show us things that they are interested in and using these we plan activities for individual and groups of our children.

Children talk with key workers and other staff about their preferences. Staff ensure they take notice of children's opinions and adapt the environment and planning as necessary.

Daily, key persons engage in circle time sessions to ensure all children have a voice and all children have opportunities to vote.

## Rule of Law

### Creating our own rules which we follow-

Our behaviour policy is applied fairly and consistently.

Children are encouraged to discuss the rules and understand the reasons for having them.

Children share their ideas for new rules for the nursery.

Children follow daily routines and are aware of nursery boundaries and expectations.

# Individual Liberty

Creating a positive view of ourselves and supporting children to develop in their own way-

Children are encouraged to be independent learners.

The children serve their own meals, lay the tables and are responsible for washing their hands before and after meals and after visiting the toilet

At circle times we discuss how the children are feeling and we use books and other resources to help children deal with their emotions.

We base our individual and adult led planning on the children's interests.

# Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Treating others how they themselves would like to be treated-

Our planning and activities reflect the diversity of our community and children are encouraged learn about a variety of faiths, communities and traditions and are encouraged to acknowledge similarities and differences.

Staff challenge stereotyping using our resources and situations which arise spontaneously in play.

We welcome Visitors to the nursery and plan trips out develop children's awareness of the wider community.
